Application Guidelines for Admission Qualification Screening

#### Admission Qualification Screening

Those who would like to apply for admission into the doctoral degree program in St. Luke's International University Graduate School of Public Health under condition (3), "A person designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (under the Public Notice of the Ministry of Education No. 118, 1989", or (4), "A person approved by the SLGSPH as having at least the equivalent academic ability as those persons mentioned in 1 to 3 above," described in "II-B. Applicant Eligibility" of the Admissions Guide should submit an application for prior screening to obtain approval from the university.

## 1. Method of Screening

The Admission Qualification Screening Committee judges each applicant's qualification based on the application documents. Those who are approved as qualifying on the basis of condition (3) or (4) may apply for 2024 Admissions into the doctoral degree program in St. Luke's International University Graduate School of Public Health.

### 2. Eligibility for Qualification Screening

Those who fulfill all of the following conditions are considered eligible:

- Holds the bachelor degree or equivalent
- Does not fulfill either of the condition (1) or (2) in the Admissions Guide
- Is at least 24 years old by the day before his or her enrollment into the program

#### 3. Required Documents

- Application Form for Admission Qualification Screening
   International applicants should submit the form in English. Native Japanese speakers are asked to submit the information in both Japanese and English.
- 2. Academic Transcript issued by the institution where the applicant obtained their highest diploma or degree. The transcript must be enclosed in an envelope sealed by the institution.
- 3. Certificate of Graduation (or Certificate of Expected Graduation) issued by the institution where the applicants obtained their highest diploma or degree. The certificate must be enclosed in an envelope sealed by the institution.
- 4. Copy of National License (if applicable)
- 5. Achievement Declaration (form designated)
- 6. Self-addressed, stamped envelope for registered mail (only applicants in Japan)

#### 4. Application Period and Application Method

Please submit the documents by registered postal mail by the deadline. The documents will not be accepted after the application period. There is no application fee associated with this application.

Deadline First Period July 3, 2023 (Mon) (postmarked by the deadline\*)

Second Period November 13, 2023 (Mon) (postmarked by the deadline\*)

Third Period January 5, 2024 (Fri) (postmarked by the deadline\*)

\*Application documents from overseas must arrive by the deadline
