

St. Luke's Graduate School of Public Health Educational Scholarship 2023

1. Main Purpose

This scholarship is aimed at reducing the financial burden of education so that students can focus on academic learning.

2. Number of Awards

Approximately 10

3. Amount of Scholarship

1,000,000 JPY (Yearly) per student for a maximum of 2 years

4. Period of Scholarship

1-year MPH program: 1 year

2-year MPH program, 3-year MPH program and Doctoral Program: 2 years*

The scholarship will be paid after the enrollment, divided into two payments per year (in May and October).

5. Eligibility

Applicants who apply for 2023 admission to the St. Luke's MPH program or Doctoral Program are considered as eligible.

6. Application Documents

(1) Scholarship Application Form

(2) Any one of the following documents of each of the applicant and all the working family members living with the applicant:

- Certificate of income and withholding tax
- Certificate of tax payment which indicates the amount of income
- Submitted income-tax returns
- Wage statement, if none of the above is available

7. Application Procedure

8. Application Period

First Block August 1 (Mon) - August 26, 2022 (Fri) (postmarked at least by Aug 26)

Second Block December 12, 2022 (Mon) - January 6, 2023 (Fri) (postmarked at least by Jan 6)

Third Block January 27 (Wed) - February 10, 2023 (Fri) (postmarked at least by Feb 10)

Fourth Block May 22 (Mon) – June 9, 2023 (Fri) (postmarked at least by Jun 9)

Notes:

- Applications submitted in the same block as the application for the admission will be accepted.
- Application documents from overseas must arrive by the last day of the period.
- The number of awards per application period is not specified, so it is possible that there will not be slots after the first period.

9. Notification of Award

Candidates will be notified of the award at the same time as the *Notification of Admissions* by postal mail (except for extenuating circumstances, results will not be provided by telephone).

10. Others

- (1) Incomplete application documents may not be accepted.
- (2) Awardees of this scholarship are not eligible for St. Luke's International University Special Scholarship (*Tokubetsu Shogakukin*).
