1. NUMBER OF STUDENTS ADMITTED

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who fulfill all of the following requirements.

- 1) Foreign nationals without permanent residency in Japan
- 2) Those who fulfill one of the following:
 - (1) Those who have been awarded a master's degree abroad (including those expected to be awarded by March 2025)
 - (2) A person who completed a distance learning course of a foreign institution while in Japan, and was awarded a master's degree or the equivalent (including those expected to be awarded by March 2025)
 - (3) Others as approved by this university's Graduate School of Nursing Science Faculty Council. *1
- 3) A person who has sufficient language ability to handle the course content given in Japanese or English.
 - (1) For applicants looking to take their courses in Japanese: Level N1 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or equivalent level.
 - (2) For applicants looking to take their courses in English (non-native English speakers): At least TOEFL 80 (iBT)/550 (PBT) or IELTS 6.0 or equivalent

*1: Applicants who do not fulfill the requirements in points 2.1 or 2.2 above should contact the Admissions Division by September 27, 2024 to confirm eligibility. If approved, the applicant may then apply for admission as in point 2 item 3.

* Applicants must contact the faculty member who is the prospective academic advisor or the chairperson of the graduate program before submitting the application.

* Nursing licenses, either those issued in Japan or abroad, are not required to apply for admission.

4. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1) **Application Form (designated form):** Fill out the application form, and attach a passport or other ID photo (4cm×3cm) taken within the last three months. Please be as detailed as possible when writing your Statement of Purpose and Research Direction.
- 2) **Master's thesis:** One copy of the applicant's Master's thesis must be submitted. If the thesis is not written in English, please attach an English abstract of the thesis.
- 3) **List of Research and Other Scholarly Publications (designated form):** List research and other scholarly publications in the designated form. Attach one copy each of no more than 5 major research reports or publications.
- 4) **Official Transcripts:** Original transcripts containing the name(s) of your university president(s) for your undergraduate and master's courses that are sealed properly in envelopes. Transcripts in languages other than English or Japanese should be accompanied by an official English translation. *2
- 5) **Official Master's Degree Certificate/Certificate of Expected Graduation:** That of your most recent university *2
- 6) **Letter of Recommendation:** One letter of recommendation is required. Applicants are advised to seek the letter from an individual who is in a position to objectively evaluate academic and professional performance. The letter must be written on the designated form and properly sealed in an envelope.

7) **Language Certificates**

- (1) For applicants looking to take their courses in Japanese: Level 1 Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or equivalent
- (2) For applicants looking to take their courses in English: (non-native speakers of English): Score certificates (TOEFL 80 (iBT)/550 (PBT) or IELTS 6.0 or equivalent)

Applicants who were awarded their degree from an institution for which the language of instruction is English are not required to submit an English proficiency certificate. If this institution is in a non-English speaking country, please submit a document verifying that the curriculum's main language is English.

*2: If original documents cannot be submitted, please submit a copy that is verified by a public institution as authentic.

8) **Application Fee: JPY 40,000 (non-refundable)**

The application fee must be paid to the specified bank account by wire transfer. The name of the payer must match that of the applicant. All remittance charges are to be borne by the applicant. Proof of payment must be included in the submitted application materials.

Applicants residing outside of Japan may be eligible for a reduction or waiver of application fees. Please contact the SLIU Admissions Division at nyushi@slcn.ac.jp for further details.

In case an applicant has entered Japan within 90 days and has not obtained the Residence Card yet, submit a copy of all pages of the passport.*³

*3: According to the Immigration Control and Refugee Act (Act No. 319 of 1951), applicants are responsible for obtaining the appropriate visa status by the time enrollment procedures begin so as not to interrupt their enrollment to the graduate school.

7. INTERVIEWS

Interviews will be individually arranged and conducted between Wednesday, November 20, 2024 and Friday, December 6, 2024.

8. SCREENING RESULTS

Date: December 18, 2024 (Wed), 3pm (Japan standard time)

Results will be sent to the applicant by email (Telephone inquiries are not accepted).

9. ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES AND TUITION

The tuition, laboratory, and facility maintenance fees for the first semester of the 2025 academic year must be paid to start the admission procedures.

Payment Period: Acceptance date - January 10, 2025 (Fri)

A Certificate of Admission will be sent upon receipt of the entrance fee.

Tuition and Fees:

- Entrance fee: JPY 400,000 to be paid at the time of enrollment procedures
- Tuition: JPY 1,100,000 (annually) to be paid in 2 parts
- Facility maintenance fee: JPY 150,000 (annually) to be paid in 2 parts

Tuition and facility maintenance fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change.

10. ENTRANCE CEREMONY

Early April 2025. Details will be provided later.

11. MISCELLANEOUS

- 1) Incomplete applications may not be accepted.
- 2) The application fee is non-refundable.
- 3) This university has a sabbatical leave program for its faculty members. Therefore, some faculty members may be away from campus for a long period of time.
