2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A person from abroad* who fulfills all of the following requirements**.

- A person who was awarded a bachelor's degree or equivalent in a foreign country
 (A person who is expected to be awarded a bachelor's degree or equivalent in a foreign
 country by the end of March 2021), or
 A person who studied a distance learning course of a foreign institution in Japan, and
 was awarded a bachelor's degree or equivalent
 (A person who is expected to be awarded a bachelor's degree or equivalent by the end
 of March 2021)
- 2) A person who has sufficient language ability to handle the course content given in Japanese or English.
 - (1) Japanese language requirements: Level N1 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or equivalent level.
 - (2) English language requirements: Minimum TOEFL 80 (iBT)/550 (PBT) for non-native English speakers or equivalent
- 3) A person who is admitted by the Graduate Program Committee of St. Luke's International University College of Nursing***
- *A person who is a foreign national and is not authorized to stay on a permanent basis by the Japanese government.
- **An applicant must contact the faculty member who is the prospective academic advisor or the chairperson of the graduate program before submitting the application.
- ***An applicant who does not meet category 1) above should contact the Graduate Program Committee by October 1, 2020 to confirm eligibility.

3. MAJORS, COURSES, AND SPECIALTIES

Applicants will select their major and specialty when applying. Only master's course is available. Applicants are also to meet with faculty they wish to have supervise them prior to applying. Courses and specialties cannot be changed after applying.

4. PROGRAM PERIODS

2 or 3 years (selective)

- The standard 3-year course will have its 2-year curriculum done over 3 years.
- Program periods cannot be changed after applying.

5. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1) **Application Form (designated form)**: Fill out the application form, and attach a passport or ID photo (4cm×3cm) taken within the last three months
- 2) **Official Transcripts**: An official transcript of all undergraduate courses with received grades or evaluations, properly sealed in an envelope, must be submitted. The transcripts should contain the name of the president of the school where the applicant completed the undergraduate program. Transcripts in other languages than English or Japanese should be accompanied by an official English translation.

3) Official College/University Certificate of (Expected) Graduation:

University-/college-issued (expected) graduation certificate or official letter indicating the date of graduation and title of degree must be submitted.

4) Letter of Recommendation (designated form): One letter of recommendation is required. An applicant is advised to seek the letter from an individual who is in a position to objectively evaluate academic and professional performance. The letter must be properly sealed in an envelope.

5) Language Certificates

- (1) The language of instruction for the applicant is Japanese: Level 1 Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or equivalent
- (2) The language of instruction for the applicant is English (non-native speakers of English): TOEFL score of 80 (iBT)/550 (PBT) or equivalent
- 6) **Application Fee**: A non-refundable fee of ¥40,000

Application fee must be paid to the specified bank account by wire transfer. Name of the payer must match that of the applicant. Proof of payment must be included in the submitted application materials. All remittance charges should be borne by the applicant.

Applicants residing outside Japan may be eligible for reduction or waiver of application fees. Please contact the SLIU Admissions Office at nyushi@slcn.ac.jp for further details.

9. ADMISSION PROCEDURES AND TUITION

The entrance fee, as well as the tuition and the laboratory and maintenance fee of the first semester must be paid to start the admission procedures.
