1. Eligibility for Application

- (1) Those who have a bachelor's degree (including those who will graduate by the time of enrollment)
- (2) Those who have obtained a bachelor's degree or equivalent in another country
- (3) Those who are recognized by the St. Luke's Graduate School of Public Health to possess an academic ability equivalent to a bachelor's degree holder.

2. Application Documents

- (1) Application Form (including CV information)
 - Complete the required application form in English, attaching a recent photo taken within the last 3 months (face from the shoulders up).
- (2) Certificate of Completion/Graduation (issued by the institution where the applicant obtained their highest diploma or degree)
- (3) Academic Transcript (issued by the institution where the applicant obtained their highest diploma or degree)
- (4) [Optional] Evidence of Proficiency in English (Any of the certificates from the following exams taken within 3 years from the date of filing is acceptable: TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, PTE, and EIKEN.)
- (5) Application Fee (Purchase a postal money order of 20,000 JPY at Japan Post Office.)

3. Submission of Application Documents

(1) Submission Only applications sent by registered postal mail will be accepted

(3) Course Tuition 60,000 JPY/credit

^{*2-} and 3-credit courses are 15 weeks duration; 1-credit courses are 5 weeks duration

- There is no upper limit to the number of credits that can be earned as a non-degree student.
- If a student enrolls in the MPH program of St. Luke's International University, up to 15 credits previously earned as a non-degree student may be counted towards MPH degree requirements.
- If three years or longer have passed since the above credits were earned, the instructor in charge of the course will determine whether the credits can be recognized.

10. Others

- (1) Incomplete application documents may not be accepted.
- (2) The Application Fee and the Registration Fee are non-refundable.
- (3) Contact the GSPH Academic and Student Affairs Office regarding inquiries.
- (4) A student ID number is given to non-degree students, and a student ID card is issued.
- (5) Non-degree students are allowed to use the following university facilities and services: Library, Computer Room, GSPH Student Lounge, Online Learning Support System "manaba," and Bicycle Parking. The Student Health Management Office is available in case of emergency. Personal lockers, computer rentals, and student discount for the JR transportation are not available.
